WINNER BRIGGSAMASCO

In a category of strong entries, BriggsAmasco was crowned as the 2014 winner after an extremely professional presentation. The judges praised the company's clear CSR policy, commitment to safety, long-term vision and dedication to training.

BriggsAmasco develops annual training plans for both staff and

operatives, and carries out most of its training at its dedicated training centre at the company's Birmingham head office.

In 2013, BriggsAmasco worked with the Liquid Roofing and the Waterproofing Association to offer a unique apprentice scheme that trains, educates and develops the UK's next generation of liquid-applied roofing contractors.

The firm is also creating a course to develop and certify operatives to a new CPCS standard for its mastic asphalt-laying machine – a UK first.

The judges were particularly impressed that BriggsAmasco shares its training facility with the industry to improve training across construction.

BriggsAmasco designed, supplied and installed 15,000 sq m of waterproofing systems on the

£600m Birmingham Gateway project for main contractor Mace.

Despite working to extremely tight deadlines, health and safety was always the number one concern and the team completed the two-year project with no RIDDOR incidents.

To ensure its safety policy is always up to date, the senior team reviews every near-miss reported and adapts company practices accordingly, while also rewarding staff for near-miss reporting.

The company also employs a dedicated training manager, full-time health and safety advisers, and is accredited under the Safecontractor scheme.

BriggsAmasco has a quality management system audited by SGS, environmental accreditations including ISO 14001 and has silver status with the Supply Chain Sustainability School.
