

CALTHORPE COMMUNITY GARDEN ROOF WORKS

In May 2024, Mace’s supply chain partner, Briggs Amasco fixed the roof of the volunteer room at Calthorpe Community Gardens.

Calthorpe Community Gardens contacted Mace about their volunteer room which had a leaking roof. With all the recent wet weather, this was causing water to enter the room and cause further damage.

Briggs Amasco are carrying out the roofing works at Woolgate Exchange. Their team looked at the roof and decided the best way to repair the leaks was to install a cold-applied waterproofing material.

Briggs Amasco carried out these works, donating £1950 worth of materials and time out of their normal working hours. This created £15,288 of social value!

These works are part of a wider scope of engagement between Mace and Calthorpe Community Gardens, with further works planned this summer!
